## Requirements

Students who wish to become Student Hā lō:

- Must be enrolled in at least six credits at Kapi'olani Community College
- Must be enrolled in the ASNS degree program
- Must have a GPA of 2.5
- Must have passed Math 140 (or an equivalent course) or above
- Must have passed mentoring course with a B or better

## Responsibilities

Student Hā lō are expected to:

- Spend 10 hrs/week mentoring and tutoring students
- Spend 4 hrs/week performing other STEM duties
- These duties vary depending upon the situation and are to be determined by STEM faculty on an "as needed" basis
- Spend 1 hr/week at the STEM Peer Mentor meeting
