The KCC STEM Program

The goal of the STEM program is to enhance the quality of the science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) instructional and outreach programs at Kapi'olani Community College, as well as to increase the number of STEM students transferring to four-year degree programs as they prepare for careers in the STEM disciplines.



Student Hā lō

Student Hā lō are KCC students who have achieved a certain level of expertise. It is the duty of the Peer Mentors to provide mentoring and tutoring to any student enrolled in a STEM course at KCC.

Benefits

Student Hā lō are paid **\$3000 a semester** for their services.



Requirements

Students who wish to become Student Hā lō:

- Must be enrolled in at least **six credits** at Kapi'olani Community College
- Must be a **STEM student**
- Must be enrolled in the **ASNS degree**
- Must have a **GPA of 2.5**
- Need to have passed **Math 140 (or an equivalent course) or above**

Responsibilities

Student Hā lō are expected to:

- Spend **10 hrs/week** mentoring and tutoring students
- Spend **4 hrs/week** performing other STEM duties
 - These duties vary depending upon the situation and are to be determined by STEM faculty on an "as needed" basis
- Spend **1 hr/week** at the STEM Peer Mentor meeting
